Gone Too Soon A Proof of Survival Story

Losing someone you Love can be the most painful thing anyone can go through in life. I learned this all too well after losing my brother tragically in a car crash on his 27th birthday July 16, 2000. It was soon after he died that we started receiving signs and messages from him.

John was driving our parent's little lime-green Toyota Tercel when he was rear-ended on the TransCanada #1 Hwy heading home from a high school reunion at Notre Dame College in Wilcox, Saskatchewan. He was excited to be meeting a friend to see a KISS Concert in Winnipeg that night. The 18-year-old driving a half-ton veered off and hit the back right corner of the Tercel, forcing it head-on into a red semi-truck going 104 KM in the opposite lane. John was killed instantly.

That night, when we

heard the news, I stayed over at my parents house and cried myself to sleep on their couch. In the middle of the night, I had a lucid dream that the



phone was ringing and I asked someone to answer it. The next morning, my boyfriend who was sleeping in the other room, told us he had the most incredible dream. He said it felt so real—we were all sitting around crying when the phone rang. He answered it and it was John on the other line asking, "What's going on? Why is everyone crying?" Shawn said, "because you died." John responded, "What? No I didn't, I'm OK, I'm on my way home!"

Because I too dreamt of the phone ringing, I truly believe that it was no ordinary dream, but the first of many visitation dreams.

The phone ringing was John's way of reaching out to us to let us know he was okay and on his way home. Although I never saw him physically walk through the door, I know he came back to us.

It was only a few months after John's passing when our family first discovered the Spiritualist

Fellowship Church. I was skeptical of mediums so attended with my mom as a way to protect her during that vulnerable time. It was during our first visit when we received a message from the Minister, Richard MacKenzie, that provided irrefutable proof to us and made us loyal attendees of the Church ever since.

Richard stood at the front of the platform and said, "I see a young man who was hit by a truck. He is holding up a pair

of skates.”

My mom immediately put up her hand. “That’s my son, he played hockey all his life!” Richard then proceeded to give us a message about a brown chest that we had in our home that contained all of his memorabilia. He described the exact placement of it in our house... down the hallway and under a framed print of a hockey player. As soon as we got home, we double-checked where it was and it was sitting exactly where he described it. There was no way to explain how he could know that unless he had made genuine contact with my brother.

More recently, at a Sunday service in February, we received a message from John through another medium named Cathy

Larsen. She said that John still plays hockey up there and that he was showing her Paul Coffey for some reason. She said she thought John could have “gone far with it” and played for the NHL. I agreed, hockey was John’s passion and his life. I myself wasn’t big into hockey so I had to look up Paul Coffey when I got home that night and when I did, I was floored. John was an amazing defenceman. The coaches always put him in defence because he skated so well backwards. He was also a really fast skater and was one of the highest scoring defencemen on his teams. John also almost always played as #7. What I found out was that Paul Coffey was an “All-Star” defenceman who made the Hockey Hall of Fame for be-

ing one of the highest scoring defencemen. Coffey also wore either #7 or #77 on his jersey. When I learned this, I was in tears—tears of joy.

If you have lost a loved one and haven’t yet attended a service at the Spiritualist Fellowship Church, I strongly recommend you do—it can provide the most amazing healing and proof of survival anywhere.
